Will be judged on the basis of fundamentals of equitation. Class may be divided into different seats as long as all are given an equal opportunity to compete.

Riders may not compete in any short stirrup classes. Riders will be asked to walk and trot in both directions of the ring. They will be judged on position and ability to control their mount. Diagonals will be considered.

Riders showing in this division may not compete in any other recognized division or recognized class in a show with fences exceeding 18" with the exception of pleasure and pet-type pony classes. To be shown over a course of four (4) to eight (8) fences at a height of 18". Fences shall be cross-rails or verticals with no combinations. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter. Riders will be judged on position over the obstacle, between obstacles and on their ability to control their mount.

Long Stirrup Equitation Fences: Judged over a course of four to eight fences placed alongside the rail. Cross rails or verticals. Maximum fence height not to exceed 2'. Combination fences are prohibited; trotting will not be penalized.

CT TRAINING HUNTER LEVELS A THROUGH D (CHSA, CHJA)

Open to all horses or ponies. No age limitations and no rider restrictions. No restriction of horse/pony/rider into other divisions if otherwise eligible. To be judged on performance, soundness, suitability and manners. Simple lead changes in corners are permitted. To be shown over a hunter type course. Combinations are optional. Fence height not less than 18" and not to exceed 2'6".

May be divided into Low and High and/or specific height sections [Level A – 18" cross rails or verticals, Level B – 2', Level C – 2'3" Level D – 2'6"]. Height sections may be combined i.e. Level B/C 2'-2'3". Show management MUST specify fence heights and sections.

Show results MUST clearly identify the specific section each horse/pony and rider combination competed in. The same horse/rider combination may not compete in more than one section at the same show. If there are fewer than 3 entries in any section divided by height, at management's discretion those sections may be combined with other sections, provided all competitors compete over the same course, with adjustments only for height and/or distance. (For example, a section consisting of twice around cross rails may not be combined with a section where the course contains a diagonal line.)

Horses and ponies may be jogged at the horse show management's discretion.

This is a two round class open to all riders to be shown over a course of eight to ten fences at 2'9" with higher options. The first round judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality and substance, and movement. The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. The top four or 25% from the first round will return to jump a handy hunter round of six to eight obstacles which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever options for jump approach, and halt and/or back. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. To fill a class, at least four horses must compete.

To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. The top four or 25% from the first round will return to jump a handy hunter round of six to eight obstacles which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever options for jump approach, and halt and/or back. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. To fill a class, at least four horses must compete. No Champion or Reserve Champion

2'9" HUNTER DERBY HUNT AND GO

This is a two round class open to all riders to be shown over a course of eight to ten fences at 2'9" with higher options. The first round to be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality and substance, and movement. The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. All riders will be invited back for the second round, a handy hunter round of six to eight fences which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever options for jump approach, and halt and/or back. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. The exhibitor will be allowed to ride the first round, leave the ring, and then return for the handy round. Both rounds can be ridden back to back. To fill a class, at least four horses must compete.

2'6" HUNTER DERBY HUNT AND GO

This is a two round class open to amateur adults and junior riders to be shown over a course of eight to ten fences at 2'9" with higher options. The first round to be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality and substance, and movement. The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. All riders will be invited back for the second round, a handy hunter round of six to eight fences which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever options for jump approach, and halt and/or back. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. The exhibitor will be allowed to ride the first round, leave the ring, and then return for the handy round. Both rounds can be ridden back to back. To fill a class, at least four horses must compete.

2'-2'3" HUNTER DERBY HUNT AND GO This is a two round class open to amateur adults and junior riders to be shown over a course of eight to ten fences at 2'-2'3" with higher options not to exceed 2'6". The first round to be judged on performance, hunter pace, style, quality and substance, and movement. The course should include at least one in and out, one bending line and one unrelated distance. The obstacles are to simulate those found in a hunt field. Natural obstacles may be used. All riders will be invited back for the second round, a handy hunter round of six to eight fences which may include at least two of the following: trot jump, tight turn option, clever options for jump approach, and halt and/or back. To be judged on style, brilliance, and handiness. Judges will adhere to USHJA Hunter Derby rules for scoring. The score will be a total of the two rounds. The exhibitor will be allowed to ride the first round, leave the ring, and then return for the handy round. Both rounds can be ridden back to back. To fill a class, at least four horses must compete.

Note: CHJA points will accrue at all heights and both formats for one combined yearend award. Horses will be eligible for a yearend award if they compete in a minimum of four shows, with no minimum number of points required.

Combining Derby Classes on Day of Show. If, on the day of a Recognized Show, any of the Hunter Derby Classes do not fill according to CHJA requirements of a minimum of four entries, then show management may combine the classes but must run each of the combined divisions at the appropriate height according to CHJA rules for that division. Riders competing in the combined class shall accumulate points in their appropriate division. If the prize list indicates in advance that any of these divisions will be combined, then they will not be pointed by the CHJA. Allowing this division to be combined on the day of the show is to benefit CHJA members that are at the show but find the divisions they entered do not have four entrants.

CHJA Medals: Open to members only. At least 3 riders must complete both the flat and fence phase. Judge will call back six competitors (if available) for the flat phase, to count 50%. The same horse/pony and rider must compete in both phases. Members may compete in only one CHJA Medal class per show.

CHSA MEDALS: Open to members and non-members, but only members accrue points. At least 3 riders must complete the class; at least one must be a CHSA member. Two tests (USEF 1-8) will be included in each course. Riders may compete in only one CHSA Medal class per show.

11. CHSA SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to riders 12 years and under as of December 1 of the current show year; at least one rider must be a current member of CHSA and all riders must be eligible for Short Stirrup Equitation. At least three entrants must complete the course in order for the class to count. Course will be 18" in height and will include two tests (USEF 1-8).

51. CHJA PRE-CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Rider to be a Junior member of the CHJA who has not shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at a recognized horse show. If a rider has ever qualified for or shown in a 2'6" Equitation final including the CHJA Children's Medal, they are no longer eligible for the Pre Children's Medal. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'0" in height, which must contain two changes of direction after the first fence with no combinations permitted. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. Riders may show horses or ponies. The same horse/pony to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least three competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current US EQUESTRIAN Tests 1-8.

52. CHSA PRE-CHILDREN'S EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders who have not reached his/her 18th birthday; at least one rider must be a current member of CHSA and all riders must be eligible for Pre-Children's Equitation. At least three entrants must complete the course in order for the class to count. Course will be 2' in height and will include two tests (USEF 1-8).

61. CHSA 2'3" EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to Junior and Amateur Adult Riders who have never shown over 2'6". At least one rider must be a current member of CHSA and all riders must be eligible for Children's Equitation. Cannot show in both CHSA 2'3" Medal and CHSA 2'6" Medal at same show. The class will be held over a course of not less than eight vertical fences at 2'3" in height, which must contain two tests from the current USEF Tests 1-8.

67. CHSA CHILDREN'S 2' 6" EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders who have not reached his/her 18th birthday; at least one rider must be a current member of CHSA and all riders must be eligible for Children's Equitation. At least three entrants must complete the course in order for the class to count. Course will be 2'6" in height and will include two tests (USEF 1-8).

109. CHSA MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to Amateur Adult Members; at least one rider must be a current member of CHSA and all riders must be eligible for Modified Adult Equitation and have not shown over a course with fences 3' or higher at more than three recognized horse shows within the past two show years. Course will be 2'6" in height and will include two tests (USEF 1-8).

108. CHJA MODIFIED ADULT MEDAL

Rider to be an Amateur Adult Member of the CHJA who is eligible for Modified Adult Equitation. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 2'6" in height, which must include two changes of direction after the first fence and no combinations. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least three competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current US EQUESTRIAN Tests 1-8.

82. CHJA PONY MEDAL

Rider to be a Junior Member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than six obstacles. Small and medium ponies to jump obstacles 2'0" in height. Large ponies to jump obstacles 2' 6" in height. A combination is optional and must be adjusted according to fence height. If the distance between obstacles is less than 72' then the distance must be adjusted for each height section. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same pony to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least three competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8.

66. CHJA CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Open to Junior members of the CHJA who are eligible for Children's Hunter, have not shown over a course where fences exceeded 3' at a Recognized show. If you have ever qualified or shown in a 3' Equitation Finals including CHJA, you are not eligible for the Children's Medal. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 2'6" in height, which must contain two changes of direction after the first fence with no combinations permitted. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by

the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least three competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-8.

93. CHJA JUNIOR MEDAL

Rider to be a Junior Member of CHJA who has not reached his/her 18th birthday. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least three competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.

124. CHJA ADULT MEDAL

Rider to be an Amateur Adult Member of the CHJA. The class consists of two phases. The first phase is shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles 3' in height, which must include one combination including an oxer, and two changes of direction (change of lead) after the first fence. Judges will select at least six contestants (if available) to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The second (flat) phase is mandatory and will count 50%. The same horse to be shown by the same rider in both phases. To fill the class at least three competitors must complete both phases of the class. Judges may require additional testing, using current USEF Tests 1-19.

68. MARSHALL & STERLING 2'6" CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show. May be combined with M&S 2'6" Adult Medal.

74. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S LARGE PONY MEDAL 2'6"

75. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S SMALL AND MEDIUM PONY MEDAL 2'

Open to Junior Riders on ponies that are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at the required height with at least two changes of direction after the first fence. A combination is optional, and must be adjusted according to fence heights. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same pony must be used in all phases. Only one rider per pony. (Riders may not ride in more than one height section of the class.) Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Horse Medal at the same show. *(Fence heights of 2'6" Large and 2'0" Small and Medium are suggested, and should be used whenever possible. If Children's Hunter Pony specifications differ, Show management may offer fence heights according to those specifications.)*

92. MARSHALL & STERLING 3' CHILDREN'S MEDAL HORSE

Open to Junior Riders on horses that are not competing at the same show in any hunter or equitation class in which the fences exceed 3'3". To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show.

96. MARSHALL & STERLING 3'6" JUNIOR MEDAL

Open to Junior Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals.

110. MARSHALL & STERLING 2'6" ADULT MEDAL

Open to Adult Amateur Riders that are not competing at the same show in any class with fences 3' or higher. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 2'6" including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. May be combined with M&S 2'6" Children's Medal.

128. MARSHALL & STERLING 3' ADULT MEDAL

Open to Adult Amateur Riders. To be shown over minimum of 8 fences at 3' including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals.

95. MARSHALL & STERLING JUNIOR/AMATEUR HORSEMANSHIP MEDAL 3'3"

Open to Juniors and Amateurs. No cross entry restrictions. Over fences phases to be shown over a minimum of 8 fences at 3'3" including at least one combination (a double and a triple are preferred) and two changes of direction after the first fence. A Liverpool is encouraged. At least 12 riders, if available, to return to show on the flat. Flat phase to include the working walk, working trot sitting, working trot rising, work trot rising showing a lengthening of stride, working canter, working canter showing a lengthening of stride, and the counter canter (no more than 12 to counter canter at the same time). The same horse must be used in all phases. Running martingale or standing martingale allowed in the jumping phase. No martingales allowed in the flat phase. Change of bridle is permissible between phases.

80. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY CLASSIC Height of fences small & medium ponies 2'; large ponies 2'6"

86. MARSHALL & STERLING CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE CLASSIC Height of fences 3' for horses

Open to Junior riders. Only M&S members will receive points. To be eligible for points, a horse/pony must complete the course in at least two classes over fences in the Children's Hunter section at the same show. To be judged on performance and soundness with manners emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 horses/ponies from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied to be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine winners. In case of tie for first place only, the tied horses/ponies will jump a third round over a shortened course to break the tie. The second class of each section of Children's Hunter will count as the rider's first round of the M&S Children's Hunter Classic. Riders must enter the M&S Hunter Classic prior to competing in the first Children's Hunter class.

118. MARSHALL & STERLING SMARTPAK ADULT HUNTER CLASSIC

Open to Amateur Adult riders. Only M&S members will receive points. To be eligible for points, a horse/pony must complete the course in at least two classes over fences in the Amateur Adult Hunter section at the same show. To be judged on performance and soundness with manners emphasized. To be scored under the open numerical judging system. The top 12 horses/ponies from the first round will return to jump a second round in reverse order of their scores in the first round; lowest score going first and highest score going last. In case of ties, order of those tied to be drawn. Scores will be averaged from both rounds to determine winners. In case of tie for first place only, the tied horses/ponies will jump a third round over a shortened course to break the tie. The second class of each section of Amateur Adult Hunter will count as the rider's first round of the M&S Adult Hunter Classic. Riders must enter the M&S Hunter Classic prior to competing in the first Children's Hunter class.

94. NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL

Open to Junior Members of the NEHC who have not reached their eighteenth birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-18). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for Medal classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

125. NEHC ADULT MEDAL

Open to Adult Amateur Members of the NEHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences not exceeding 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF Tests 1-19). To fill a class; at least four competitors must complete the course. One win required for the finals. All contestants must wear proper attire. Once a contestant has qualified, they are no longer eligible for Medal classes. Violation will forfeit eligibility for the finals for that year.

73. BIT O' STRAW HUNTER CLASSIC

Open to Junior or Amateur riders. No cross entry of horse/pony or rider into the M&S Children's or Adult Hunter Classic. *No cross entry of rider into any USEF rated hunter division.* Fences 2'6"

159. MHC HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL

Open to members of MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday as of December 1st of the current year and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combination fences, at a height not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual tests may be requested at the Judge's discretion. (USEF Tests 1-5). To fill a class, a least 4 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the MHC Mini Medal or the MHC Adult Mini Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights. Ten points to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in this class.

160. MHC 2'6" ADULT MINI MEDAL

Open to Adult Members of the MHC who have not jumped 2'9" or higher in the past 2 years. All contestants are to perform over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combinations and a height not to exceed 2'6" for horses and ponies. To fill a class, a least 4 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the MHC Mini Medal or the MHC Adult Mini Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights. Ten points to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in this class.

161. MHC 3' JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL

Open to Junior members of the MHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the Judges' discretion. (USEF Tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the MHC Junior Medal or the MHC Adult Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights. After qualifying, contestant is no longer eligible to enter the class.

162. MHC ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL

Open to adult members of MHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6" to 2'9", with at least 1 change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF Test 1-19). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the MHC Junior Medal or the MHC Adult Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights. After qualifying, contestant is no longer eligible to enter the class.

163. MHJ SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL Class # 10 of the Short Stirrup Equitation Division

164. MHJ MINI MEDAL Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, with the exception of maiden and novice riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1. To perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 2'6". Competitors may cross enter into the MHJ Children's Medal Horse or Pony class at the Finals. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1, 2014. After August 1, only those riders not qualified may compete in the Class

165. MHJ CHILDREN'S MEDAL- Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1, and who have

not shown over a course where the fences have exceeded 3'. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences the required height, including a combination and at least two changes of direction after the first fence. The same horse must be used in all phases. Sm/med ponies to jump 2' and large ponies/horses to jump 2'6". Only one rider per horse. Competitors may not cross enter into the MHJ Mini Medal or NEHJ Junior Talent Medal at the Finals. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified riders may continue to show in the class until August 1. After August 1 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

166. MHJ JUNIOR MEDAL Open to junior members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current year. All contestants are required to perform over at least 6 fences not exceeding 3'. Competitors may cross enter in the NEHJ Junior Talent Medal. To fill a class, at least two competitors must complete the course. Ten points are required to qualify for the Finals. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1. After August 1 only those riders not qualified may compete in the classes.

167. MHJ ADULT MINI MEDAL -Open to Amateur Adults who have not shown over a course where the fences exceed 3' in the current year. To perform over at least 6 fences not to exceed 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into the MHJ Adult Medal or the NEHJ Adult Talent Medal. At least 2 riders must complete the course. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1. After August 1 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.

168. MHJ ADULT MEDAL Open to all Amateur Adult competitors to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least 2 changes of direction and a combination. At the finals, class will be divided 18-30 and over 30. At least 2 riders must complete the course in order for points to count. To qualify: 10 points. Once qualified, riders may continue to show in the class until August 1. After August 1 only those riders not qualified may compete in the class.
